

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, a special meeting of the North Mankato City Council was held in the Municipal Building Council Chambers on July 8, 2010. Mayor Zellmer called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. asking that everyone join in the Pledge of Allegiance. Public Hearing, 8:30 a.m. – Continuation of Annexation of Nicollet County Right-of-Way Plat No. 26, 107.60 Acres

Mayor Zellmer opened the public hearing which was continued from July 6, 2010 to consider annexation of Nicollet County Right-of-Way Plat No. 26. Administrator Sande reported it was necessary to continue the public hearing awaiting the completion of eminent domain of the 107.60 acres for the extension of County State Aid Highway 41/Carlson Drive/Howard Drive. Attorney Kennedy reported this property is now owned by Nicollet County and will be deeded to the City of North Mankato. With no one appearing before the Council, this portion of the meeting was closed.
