SUBJECT: Caswell Park Recap - 2011

In 2011, many youth organizations, high schools and other groups hosted 19 weekend tournaments at Caswell Park. Tournaments began in April and ended in October. We do not have numbers of how many people attended each tournament as tournament directors did not always charge a gate fee, however, below is a breakdown of the number of teams that participated in each tournament:

Total concession revenue for the year was \$88,199.49.

Some of the major tournaments North Mankato hosted in 2011 were the MSHSL Girls' State Fastpitch Softball tournament, ASA Boy's and Men's National Fastpitch tournaments, the Men's Modified Nationals and the Women's C and D Northern National Tournaments. The MSHSL banquet hosted 829 people at the Verizon Wireless Center which was the highest number we have hosted for the banquet. The City of North Mankato received the James Farrell award from ASA for hosting four of the highest rated tournaments in 2011.

In 2012, North Mankato will be hosting the ASA Men's Class A, B and C West National Fastpitch Tournaments. The ASA Girls' National 10-18 Slow Pitch and ASA Boy's/Men's National Fastpitch tournaments will be held at Caswell Park in 2013.

SUBJECT: Budget Workshop of November 21, 2011

The enclosed worksheets reflect two changes to the proposed budget. The first is a 5.00% increase in building permit and plan review fees expected to generate an additional \$10,900 in 2012. The second is a reduction of \$6,000 in the non-capital equipment portion of the Police Budget. This will be accomplished by purchasing the Varda Alarm requested by the Police Department with equipment certificate funds on hand during the current fiscal year. The revised total budget adjustments amount to \$251,600. This will enable the total levy to be reduced to \$5,148,626 which is a 6.95 percent increase over the prior year.

If we are able to identify any additional future savings or enhanced revenues, we would request that the Council reserve those as a contingency against unknown future budget impacts or as a means to replenish reserves.

Also enclosed are the line item comparisons requested at the last meeting. Please let us know if you have questions.
